TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

Total Athletes Bracket: Men – Maximum 368 players in Double Elimination format to 128 players. Single Elimination in following rounds to Final.

Women – Maximum 96 players in Double Elimination format to 32 players. Single Elimination in following rounds to Final.

Tournament Criteria: Invitational Open Championship

Ranking Points: JPBA, WPA World Ranking and Asian Ranking Points

TOURNAMENT FORMAT – MEN 10 BALL

Main Event Qualifying, 14th Sep: Double Elimination:
Open Chart with a total maximum of 368 players competing in a Double Elimination format to determine the 128 players for Single Elimination Rounds. The total number of players will be divided into a few Groups and will be playing their matches in 5-6 Pool Hall within the Suburbs of Tokyo. These Pool Hall will be confirmed to players later.

Qualifiers Knock-Out Rounds, 15th Sep: Single Elimination:
128 players from Day 1 qualifiers to compete in a Single Elimination format to determine the last 16 players for the final day Knock-Out Rounds. All matches will be played in "BILLIARD ROSA" Pool Hall, Nishi-ikebukuro, Ikebukuro, Toshima-ku, Tokyo.

Last 16 To Final Rounds, 16th Sep: Single Elimination:
16 Players from Day 2 Knock-Out rounds will play on Single Elimination format in the Finals Round to determine the Winners of this Championship. All matches will be played at "New Pia Hall, Kaigan, Minato-ku, Tokyo.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT – WOMEN 9 BALL

- Main Event Qualifying, 15th Sep: Double Elimination:
Open Chart with total maximum of 96 players competing in a Double Elimination format to determine the 32 players for Single Elimination Rounds. Players will be playing their matches in Pool Hall within Tokyo. The Pool Hall will be confirmed to players later.
- Single Elimination:
32 players from Double Elimination will continue to play the Single Elimination Knock-Out rounds on the same day at the same venue. 8 players will advance to the next day Quarterfinals at the "New Pia Hall, Kaigan, Minato-ku, Tokyo.
- Quarterfinals to Final Rounds, 16th Sep: Single Elimination:
8 Women Players from Day 1 Knock-Out rounds will play on a Single Elimination format in the Quarterfinals Knock-Out Rounds to determine the Winners of this Championship.

BREAKING & RACKING OF BALLS

All Matches for Men & Women: All Matches are played on a Winner's Breaks format from start of tournaments to the Finals. Lag for Opening Break.

All Players responsible for their own Racking of Balls with Rack-Sheet.

Racking: Men 10 Ball – 1 Ball on Spot
Women 9 Ball - 1 Ball on Spot.

Timing of Play: Tablet clock is used on the 16th, 40 seconds per shot for both men and women, and 40 seconds per extension per rack.

Prize money for the best 16 or better for the men and the best 8 or better for the women will be transferred later in USD within 30 days from September 20. (Rate of Exchange may fluctuate).

All other players not listed above will be paid in Japanese yen on the day of the tournament.

A withholding tax of 20.42% is imposed on the prize money for All Foreign players.

DRESS CODE

Men:	Smart Casual Attire – Polo shirt (Tucked-In)/Long or Short Sleeves shirt/Long-Pants and Dark-Color Shoes are encouraged. Final Day – Formal Attire with Long Sleeves Shirt/Long-Pants/Dark-Color Shoes and Bow-Tie or Tie are required.
Women:	Smart Casual Attire – Polo shirt (Tucked-In)/Long-sleeves shirt/Long-Pants and Dark-Color Shoes are encouraged. Final Day – Formal Attire with Long Sleeves Shirt/Long-Pants and Dark-Color Shoes required.
Prohibited Clothing:	Jeans, Short Pants, Round-Neck T-Shirt, Sandals, Open Toes Shoes/Slippers, Flashy Colored Shoes, Shorts, Bermuda's, Skirts, Hoodies, Hats, Caps, Earphones, Headphones or Ear Buds. (hearing aids are permitted)

ORGANIZERS AND SPONSORS PATCH

Athletes are required to put on the badges/patches/stickers provided by the Organizer during the tournament, if necessary.

The Organizer reserves the right to refuse any badges/patches/stickers/logo of Athletes if they are found to be distasteful or contradict to the sponsors of JPBA.

GENERAL RULES

No smoking is permitted in the tournament venue except in designated smoking areas.

Athletes are not allowed to use their handphones during matches and are required to switch their mobile phones and/or electronic devices to silent.

Athletes must be on their best behavior whilst in the tournament venue and must not say or do anything that may discredit the organizers, the sponsors, and/or bring disrepute to the sport.

MATCH DISPUTES

All match enquires or disputes will be referred to the Referee in the first instance. If an Athlete requires further resolution, he may approach the Chief Referee during the tournament and his/their decision will be final.

At any point of time, only the Athletes can raise any enquiries.

Any Athletes aggrieved by any action(s) and/or decision(s) made by the Referee and/or Chief Referee, he may lodge an official protest in writing to the Tournament Director within 24 hours of the incident and/or must be before his next match start. Any Protest must be accompanied by a payment of USD\$ 200 Protest Fee, payable to the Organizer. The USD\$ 200 Protest Fee will only be refund if the Tournament Director deems the protest to be valid.

All protest and disciplinary matters shall be referred to the Tournament Director, who will then be in consultation with the Organizer, will decide on the matter. His decision shall be final and binding.

TOURNAMENT AUTHORITY

The Organizers, Tournament Director and/or Chief Referee may refuse entry or disqualify an Athlete for refusing to adhere to the tournament instructions given by the Organizers, Tournament Director, and/or Chief Referee.

The Organizer reserves the right to amend or add-in, whenever necessary, additional rules to the existing one without prior notification to the Athletes.

Any matters not covered by the above set of rules and regulations shall be decided upon by the Tournament Director in consultation with the Organizer whose decision in such matter shall be final and binding.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Organizer reserves the full right to reject, cancel and refund any applications. Any remittance charges required for the payment and refund of entry fees and prize monies will be borne completely by the applicant.

Prize winners are responsible for any tax declaration/payments and withholding taxes if applicable.

Participants of the tournament understand and agree that the final decision in the acceptance of entry to the tournament lies solely with the JPBA, and will not hold JPBA (including its directors, members, servants or agents) liable for any loss, damage, and/or other expenses incurred as a result of any rejections and cancellations of applications; changes, delays and/or postponement/cancellation of the tournament. In the event of cancellation of the tournament, all entry fees paid will be refunded without interest, less any bank/remittance charges.

Participants accept and confirm that they will comply with all safe distancing measures and/or requirements under prevailing law in Japan and abide by the 2021 World Anti-Doping Code as may be revised from time to time by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).

All Participants agreed to grant JPBA or its directors, servants or agents the irrevocable and unrestricted right to use and publish photographs and videos of the participants, for but not limited to editorial, trade, advertising, and any other purposes and in any manner and medium; and to alter and composite the same without restriction and the Participant(s) inspection or approval. The Participant(s) hereby release JPBA or its directors, servants or agents from all claims and liability relating to the said photographs and videos.
